- Wear their Junior Civic Mayor polo to all events or the Mayoral robes when required.
- Be supported by their School/Teacher and their Family.





As part of our plans to become Child Friendly Doncaster, Doncaster Council's Partnerships and Engagement team recognise the importance of Children's voice and participation within those plans.

In 2019 with the support of The Civic Mayor and Members Services we re-established the Junior Civic Mayor role and 2020 launched the Primary Ambassadors.
