We look forward to seeing everyone supporting our children and cheering as loudly as possible on the school field!

Thank you again for your constant support this term - attending parent sessions, supporting school visits etc. It is greatly appreciated and valued. There is still lots of events coming up after the holidays, so please check the calendar on our website and app to make sure nothing is missed!

We were exceptionally proud of the resilience and determination every child in year 6 showed during KS2 SATs week earlier this month; they showed positivity and were keen to show the efforts of their hard work. Almost every child attended our KS2 SATs breakfast club too and we were able to provide this thanks to one of our previous parents, Mrs Falcus, who is a Community Champion for Warburton's Bakery. Warburton's provided the children with bread for toast, bagels and crumpets, as well as cereals, milk, margarine, jam, and chocolate spread, and staff from across the school helped to prepare and serve the breakfast each morning – the children had a wonderful feast each morning to start their day!

After the half-term break, our children in year 1 will have their phonics learning assessed through the National Phonics Screening Check and our year 4 children will have their times table knowledge assessed through the National year 4 Multiplication Check – please see the diary dates at the end of this newsletter for specific dates.

You may have seen on our Facebook page the pictures of the hot air balloon visit. Although the weather conditions were not conducive to launching the hot air balloon, the experience provided fantastic memories for children and staff alike!

Important Changes for children's Leave of Absence from school in term time, including holidays

Further to our previous newsletter at the start of May, we have received some guidance from Doncaster Local Authority on the new Department for Education statutory guidance that comes into force from 19th August 2024.

We have been advised that from 1st September 2024 the following changes will apply:

- In the first instance of unauthorised absence of 5 days or more, there will be an increase in the rate of a Penalty Notice Fine rising from £120 to £160 per parent per child, if paid within 28 days OR rising from £60 to £80 per parent per child, if paid within 21 days.
- In the second instance of unauthorised absence of 5 days or more within 3 years, a second Penalty Notice Fine will be issued to the same parent(s) for the same child(ren) within a rolling 3-year period. This will be charged at a higher rate of £160 per parent per child with no option for this second instance to be discharged at the lower rate of £80.
- In the third (or subsequent) instance(s) of unauthorised absence of 5 days or more within 3 years, the Local Authority will consider the use of another tool, such as prosecution or one of the other attendance legal interventions in response.
